

MASKING STATUS

Open Hands Midway uses the guidelines of the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH), and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) to determine our masking policy we will adhere to during **ALL** of our meal and food programs. Signs will be placed on our entry door which state either **MASKS REQUIRED** or **MASKS OPTIONAL**. Everyone who attends must comply with this signage in order to enter the facility. We will always have a limited supply of masks available for those who are in need of one or want one.

We will do what is in the best interest of all in order to keep everyone safe and prevent the spread of COVID-19, influenza, common colds or other infectious diseases. People may choose to mask at any time. People with symptoms, a compromised health issue, a positive COVID-19 test, or exposure to someone with COVID-19, influenza, common colds or other infectious diseases should wear a mask regardless of the signs posted at Open Hands Midway.
